

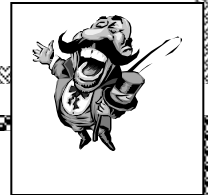


# Newsletter No 7 -15

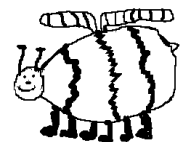
